**LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT 3,420 METRES OF PIPELINE BETWEEN THE
156 COMPRESSOR STATION AND DAWN COMPRESSOR STATION
AND 1,447 METRES OF STORAGE GATHERING PIPELINES WITHIN
THE DAWN 156 POOL AND THE DAWN 59-85 POOL
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF DAWN-EUPHEMIA, COUNTY OF LAMBTON**

**LICENCE TO DRILL WELLS WITHIN THE DAWN 156 AND DAWN 59-85 GAS
STORAGE POOLS, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF DAWN-EUPHEMIA, COUNTY OF
LAMBTON**

Union Gas Limited (the "Applicant" or "Union") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the "Board") dated June 14, 2007, under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. The Applicant has applied for an order of the Board for leave to construct approximately 3,420 metres of 36 inch Nominal Size Pipe ("NPS") pipeline between the 156 Compressor Station and the Dawn Compressor Station and 1,447 metres of 10 inch, 12 inch and 16 inch NPS storage gathering pipelines within the Dawn 156 Pool ("156 Pool") and the Dawn 59-85 Pool ("59-85 Pool"). Union Gas has proposed to increase the deliverability of the 156 Pool and the 59-85 Pool to meet the needs of customers seeking high deliverability storage services. The proposed facilities are located in the Township of Dawn-Euphemia, in the County of Lambton.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2007-0663 to this Application.

The proposed 36 inch NPS pipeline connects to the 156 Compressor Station at Lot 31, Concession 1, Dawn-Euphemia Township, and runs southerly to Dawn in Lot 26, Concession 2, Dawn-Euphemia Township. A map showing the location of the proposed pipelines is included as appendix "A" in this Notice.

By a letter, dated June 12, 2007, the Ministry of Natural Resources, Petroleum Resources Centre, has referred to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"), pursuant to section 40 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B), an application by Union for licences to drill 5 injection/withdrawal wells in the 156 Pool and the deepening of the recently drilled stratigraphic test well (EB-2007-0010) in the 156 pool so that it can be used as an injection/withdrawal well and to drill 5 new injection/withdrawal wells in the 59-85 Pool.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2007-0661 to this Application.

A map showing the location of the proposed wells is included as appendix "A" in this Notice. The wells are located in the Township of Dawn-Euphemia, in the County of Lambton.

How to see the Applicant's Pre-filed Evidence

Copies of the applications and the pre-filed evidence in support of the applications will be available for public inspection at the Board's offices, at the Union Gas Limited's head office and in the case of the licences to drill wells application at the office of Petroleum Resources Centre in London (addresses below).

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

You may send the Board a letter of comment. Your letter may include a request to make an oral presentation to the Board, and must be received by the Board no later than **30 days** from the publication date of this notice.

You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this notice.

You may request intervenor status if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter of intervention received no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this notice, or, if you have been served this notice personally, no later than **10 days** from the date of service. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.
