The closing date for the Downstream Pipeline Balancing Service Open Season has been extended to May 10, 2007.

If you wish to participate in this Open Season, please sign and return the Downstream Pipeline Balancing Service Term Sheet by fax to (519) 436-4643, Attention: Wayne Passmore on or before 12:00 noon Eastern Time on Thursday, May 10, 2007. The form is included in the April 5, 2007 posting on www.uniongas.com/openseason. Union will advise each Shipper by written notice on or before 2:30 p.m. Eastern Time Tuesday, May 15, 2007 of the actual quantity awarded to Shipper, if any.

The Downstream Pipeline Balancing Service (DPB Service) is a new short notice balancing service designed to provide flexibility to power generators or others, who source their gas at Dawn, for delivery downstream of either Kirkwall or Parkway. DPBS is available to all existing M12 transportation Shippers or Shippers recently awarded an M12 Transportation Contract in Union's 2008 Transportation Open Season. DPB Service will commence as early as July 1, 2008, dependant on requests for service.

The DBP Service includes a deliverability component and a small storage and loan account, on Union's system, just upstream of Parkway or Kirkwall (dependent on the delivery point of the Shippers designated M12 Transportation Contract). Injections and withdrawals are available with as little as 15 minutes notice. The service is designed to integrate seamlessly with TCPL's FT-SN Service.
