Union Gas Limited ("Union") announces a binding Open Season for up to 100,000 GJ/d of Dawn to Dawn/Vector Firm Transportation capacity for service commencing July 1, 2008, utilizing existing facilities. This open season is in accordance with Union's C1 Transportation rate schedule. Please visit <http://www.uniongas.com/aboutus/regulatory/rates/ratesindex.asp>.

Historically, any shipper request to transport gas westerly from Dawn to Dawn/Vector interconnect (backhaul) was subject to interruption. . As the physical flows arriving from Vector have offset the requests for backhauls into Vector, Union has been able to accommodate all nominated activity, and have provided the backhaul service at no cost to the Shipper.

Union will continue to offer an interruptible service, in addition to a new firm transportation service approved by the Ontario Energy Board, effective January 1, 2008. Union's offering will accommodate shippers request for increased reliability and flexibility. A firm transportation service from Dawn to Dawn/Vector interconnect will allow shippers reliability to capture market opportunities when market pricing favours exports from Dawn and supports changing market dynamics.

Service Parameters

- Fuel will be provided by shipper according to Union's C1 Rate schedule which is subject to revision from time to time. A copy of this rate schedule is available at <http://www.uniongas.com/aboutus/regulatory/rates/ratesindex.asp>
- Receipt point - Dawn.
- Delivery point - Dawn/Vector
- Service commencement - Maximum 2 year term starting as early as July 1, 2008.
- Demand Charge - Minimum Bid - \$0.042 GJ/d/month
- Summer fuel ratio only - 0.206% (shipper provide fuel)

Union will evaluate all binding offers using the product of the Demand Charge Bid (Minimum Bid \$0.042 CDN/GJ/d/month) and term (years) (the "Value"), with bids resulting in the highest overall total Value having the highest priority. If two or more successful bids have an equivalent Value, and insufficient capacity exists to satisfy all such bids with an equivalent Value, the capacity allocated to such bids will be prorated.

By participating in this Open Season, subject to Union's acceptance and notification of quantities allocated to Shipper, Shipper hereby (a) irrevocably commits to enter into the C1 Firm Transportation Contract for Firm Transportation Service (found at www.uniongas.com/openseason) (the "C1 Contract") with Union on the price and capacity as outlined below, and (b) represents and warrants that all conditions precedent for the benefit of Shipper set forth in Section 3.02 of the C1 Contract are satisfied or waived. If Shipper does not enter into the C1 Contract within 30 days of delivery by Union of written notice to Shipper, Union may, in its sole discretion, elect by written notice to Shipper within 15 days thereafter, to either terminate its provision of Firm Transportation Services to Shipper, or treat Shipper's signature and return of this C1 Firm Transportation Bid Form together with the C1 Contract as the legally binding agreement (modified as applicable by Union's notification of the quantities allocated to Shipper) between Shipper and Union for the Firm Transportation Services outlined below. Shipper acknowledges and agrees that any Firm Transportation Services provided by Union prior to execution by Shipper of the C1 Contract shall be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this C1 Firm Transportation Bid Form and the C1 Contract. In the event of any inconsistency or conflict between the terms and conditions of this C1 Firm Transportation Bid Form and the C1 Contract, this C1 Firm Transportation Bid Form shall prevail to the extent of any inconsistency.
