**RE: ENHANCED LOAN SERVICE AGREEMENT**

This Enhanced Loan Service Agreement (“**Agreement**”) confirms the existence of an Interruptible Service Hub Contract (HUB [ ]) (the “**Contract**”) between [Shipper Name] (“**Shipper**”) and Union Gas Limited (“**Union**”). In addition to the terms and conditions of the Contract, Shipper has requested and Union has agreed to provide an additional “**Enhanced Loan Service**”. All basic terms and conditions of the Contract shall be applicable to this Enhanced Loan Service, and during the term of this Agreement, the Contract may not be terminated by Shipper or Union, except as defined in the Default and Termination section of the General Terms & Conditions. In the event of any other discrepancy or conflict in the terms and conditions between the Contract and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall supersede and take precedence over the Contract. This Agreement shall provide the following:

1. Union shall provide Shipper an Enhanced Loan Service (“**Service**”) at [Point] (the “**Loan Point**”), for the period of [Start Date] to [End Date], for a quantity of [ ] GJ ([ ] MMBtu) (the “**Contracted Quantity**”).
2. (a) For the period of [Month day, year] to [Month day, year], inclusive, Union shall deliver to Shipper, and Shipper shall accept from Union the Contracted Quantity at the Loan Point. For the period [Month day, year] to [Month day, year], Shipper is obligated to accept from Union, on a firm basis, each and every day, the amount of [ ] GJ/day ([ ] MMBtu/day) and for [Month day, year(last day)], a quantity of [ ] GJ ([ ] MMBtu) (collectively referred to as the “**Daily Withdrawal Quantity**”).  
  
(b) In the event that Shipper fails to accept delivery of the Daily Withdrawal Quantity from Union as specified above, Shipper agrees to pay \$3.000000/GJ (\$3.1651680/MMBtu) multiplied by the difference between the actual quantity accepted by Shipper and the Daily Withdrawal Quantity (the “**Loan Shortfall**”). In addition, should Union choose to sell the Loan Shortfall at [Point] and buy it back at [Point] in [Month, year], Shipper agrees to pay Union’s costs to replace such gas (which will include the net cost to sell and buy back such gas), plus an additional 25%. If Union chooses not to replace such gas, Shipper agrees to pay \$0.1500000/GJ (\$0.1582584/MMBtu) multiplied by the Loan Shortfall for each day that the Loan Shortfall, or any portion thereof, exists.
3. Shipper agrees to pay Union for this Service, a demand charge of \$ [ ] [currency], which shall be invoiced in [number (#)] equal monthly installment(s) of \$ [ ] [currency] for the months of [Month, year] to [Month, year] inclusive.

4. (a) For the period of [Month day, year] to [Month day, year], Shipper shall deliver to Union the Contracted Quantity at [Point] (the "Return Point"). For the period of [Month day, year] to [Month day, year], inclusive, Shipper shall deliver [ ] GJ/day ( [ ] MMBtu/day) on a firm basis, each and every day; and for [Month day, year(last day)], a quantity of [ ] GJ ( [ ] MMBtu). (collectively referred to as the "Daily Injection Quantity").
- (b) In the event that Shipper fails to deliver the Daily Injection Quantity to Union as specified above, Shipper agrees to pay \$3.000000/GJ (\$3.1651680/MMBtu) multiplied by the difference between the actual quantity of gas delivered by Shipper and the Daily Injection Quantity (the "Shortfall"). In addition, should Union choose to replace such Shortfall, Shipper agrees to pay Union's costs to replace such gas at the Return Point, plus an additional 25% of such costs. If Union chooses not to replace such gas, Shipper agrees to pay \$0.150000/GJ (\$0.1582584/MMBtu) multiplied by the Shortfall for each day that the Shortfall, or any portion thereof, exists. Union retains the right to replace the Shortfall at any time that the Shortfall, or any portion thereof, remains. Upon notice of failure to deliver the Daily Injection Quantity to Union as specified above, Union may terminate this Service.
5. Notwithstanding Section 12.02 of the Contract under which this Service is offered, should Union, acting reasonably, solely determine that Shipper's financial condition warrants such, Shipper shall within (3) three days of receipt of such notice by Union, obtain and provide to Union, a letter of credit or other security in the form and amount reasonably required by Union.
6. Union and Shipper agree that any delivery to the Loan Point, nominated by Union to the downstream transporter for delivery to Shipper, is subject to acceptance by the downstream transporter. To the extent that the downstream transporter is unable to accept such quantities this shall not be deemed a failure to deliver by Union.
7. This Agreement will take effect immediately.

Please acknowledge your agreement to the above terms and conditions by signing and returning both copies of this Agreement to **Union Gas Limited, 50 Keil Drive North, P.O. Box 2001, Chatham, ON, N7M 5M1; Attention: S&T Contracting** for execution by Union, whereby this shall then constitute a binding Agreement as between the parties.
