Enbridge Gas Inc. Binding Open Season – Parkway to Dawn Standard C1 – Invitation to Bid

Enbridge Gas Inc. is holding an open season for standard C1 transportation service (“Open Season”) for 700,000 GJ/d of Parkway to Dawn capacity beginning November 1, 2020 for a minimum one-year term.

All bids are due on or before 2 p.m. ET / 1 p.m. CT, on Oct. 23, 2020. Enbridge Gas expects to award capacity on or before 4 p.m. ET/3 p.m. CT on Oct. 23, 2020.

Submitting a Bid for Service and awarding capacity

Enbridge Gas, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received, terminate the Open Season, or modify or extend the Open Season or related documents. All capacity requests that meet the respective service parameters during this Open Season will be awarded as per Enbridge Gas’ Allocation Procedures in Section XVI of the Enbridge Gas C1 tariff General Terms and Conditions, starting with those bids with the highest economic value.

If the economic values of two or more independent bids are equal, then service shall be allocated on a pro-rata basis. The economic value shall be based on the net present value which shall be calculated based on the proposed per unit rate and the proposed term of the contract and without regard to the proposed contract demand.

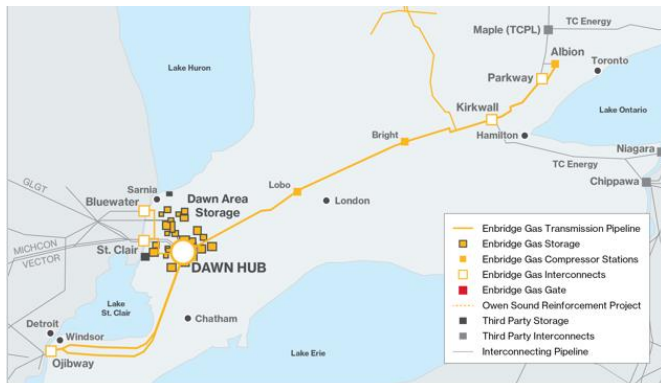
Any suggested conditions precedent proposed by the bidder should be clearly articulated and will be considered during the capacity allocation process.

All bids are due on or before 2 p.m. ET/ 1 p.m. CT, on Oct. 23, 2020. Enbridge Gas expects to award capacity on or before 4 p.m. ET/ 3 p.m. CT on Oct. 23, 2020.

Any party wishing to submit a bid for C1 service should provide a bid under the above terms and conditions by email indicating the Quantity and Term of your bid, as well as if the bid is subject to any conditions precedent in addition to the standard preconditions in Section XXI_of the Schedule "A 2010" Rate C1 General Terms and Conditions.

About the Enbridge Gas Dawn Hub

The Enbridge Gas Dawn Hub is the largest integrated natural gas storage facility in Canada and one of the largest in North America. It offers customers, such as power generators, distribution and pipeline companies and energy marketers, an important link in the movement of natural gas from key supply basins to markets in central Canada and the northeast U.S.
